Valentine's Day Pop-Up Card

Materials:

- Printer paper, or cardstock
- Pencils, markers, crayons, colored pencils, pen, or paint
- Scissors

Step 1:

Gather your materials. To start you will need a blank piece of paper or cardstock (though cardstock will have better results for this particular craft), pencil, crayons, pens, markers, paint, or another tool you can use to design your card, and scissors.

Step 2:

Draw your design on your card with a pencil.

Step 3:

Color in your design with your pens, markers, colored pencils, or paint.

Step 4:

Once your design is colored in, fold your paper or cardstock vertically. Draw a heart so that the crease of the paper falls along the middle of the heart.

Step 5:

With your scissors, cut along the top and bottom of the heart. Make sure not to cut along the entirety of the heart. Cutting only the top and bottom, and not the middle, will allow the heart to pop out, but not fall out of the card.

Step 6:

Now that you've cut part of the heart, open your card and push your finger against the heart to make it pop out.

Step 7:

Finally, decorate the pop-out heart, and don't forget to write a a note!
